

# HMDA Partial Exemptions: How do you spell relief? (Webinar)

Instructions for implementing the partial HMDA exemptions for smaller reporters were issued on Friday, August 31, 2018 by the Bureau for Consumer Financial Protection via an interpretive and procedural rule. These rules implement the changes made to HMDA by the *Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief, and Consumer Protection Act* that was signed into law on May 24, 2018. The partial exemptions apply only to banks that meet a lower reporting threshold AND have "at least a satisfactory CRA rating". It is important to understand the entire rule for the partial exemptions.
