

Risk Reduction/Confirming Legal Descriptions (Webinar)

Vizaline offers visualization tools and products to help bankers better understand their assets, protect their portfolio and protect their customers. Viza-Plat validates the bank's legal description so banks know what they are lending upon before disbursing funds. It identifies issues with the legal description including easements, partial releases and non-closure of the description. Most banks also use it on renewal of loans so that their portfolio is free of legal description problems.

Webinar Speaker

Brent Melton spent 42 years in banking primarily in the lending area. His experience consists of Commercial Lending, Compliance and Mortgage Banking. During his career, he assisted many banks in the development of their mortgage banking business and was instrumental in bringing mortgage banking to many banks in Ms., Al., Tn. and La. during the 80's. Upon retirement he organized Vizaline, LLC to assist banks with metes and bounds legal description issues. In four years Vizaline has expanded to five states in the Southeast and 40 banking relationships ranging from \$100MM to \$3B in assets. This year Vizaline will be expanding to several additional states in the Midwest and Northeast.
