- Completeness Testing Developing a process for ensuring all reportable originated loans and non-originated applications are captured
 - Types of transactions covered and what transactions are exempt
 - Challenges when reporting the action taken for non-originated applications
- Fields that can be exempted for small filers and how to report them correctly
 - o Blank vs. "Exempt" vs. "NA" vs. "1111"
- Scenarios, clarifications, and tricks for each key field
- How to collect and report government monitoring information (ethnicity, race, and sex)
- Procedures regarding source documentation to demonstrate compliance
- Record retention and documentation needed to demonstrate compliance

This is tailored for banks utilizing loan origination software systems such as Laser Pro. The class will also provide bankers with answers to common questions relating to data collection and reporting. Attendees will be encouraged to present example loan scenarios for the question and answer portion.
